Clause 4.14 Research Publication

A student with minimum CGPA of 8.00 without history of arrear can register for the course on 'Research Publication'. The outcome of the course will be a publication in SCI/SCI-expanded/SCOPUS indexed journals in Science and Technology. Number of Credits for this course is 3. A maximum of two (2) students can form a team and register for this course at the beginning of the fifth semester of the programme. The student shall work under a faculty advisor who has published at least 5 papers in SCI/SCI-expanded/SCOPUS indexed journals. On producing the evidence of the research publication, through faculty advisor and Head of the Department, grade and credits will be awarded in the following semester. The grades will be awarded as per the details in the following Table.

If the student is not able to publish within seventh semester, the registration will be automatically canceled and he/she has to meet the credit requirements for the elective category by registering necessary elective course in eighth semester, if required. Further, if a student has not registered for this research course in fifth semester but meets all the requirements for earning the credits in this course, the student will be allowed to replace his/her grade and credits earned from 'Programme Specific Elective' or 'Programme Specific Elective for Expanded Scope' with grade and credits earned from this course.

4.6	<p>Every student is expected to undergo In-plant training in any industry/organization during the programme of study. Every 2 weeks of internship/training at industry is equivalent to 1 credit. The credit will be awarded to the student after the submission of internship/training report to the Head of the Department. The report will be evaluated by a team of faculty members nominated by the Head of the Department for awarding the grade. Based on the recommendation by the team, the student will be awarded credits and the results will be sent to The Controller of Examinations after the approval by the Head of the Department. The final semester project period at industry/research organization will not be considered as industrial training/internship. The maximum number of credits that can be earned from internship is limited to 2.</p>	<p>Each student has to undergo In-plant training or summer internship in an industry or at the institution. Two weeks of internship/training at industry/institution is equivalent to 1 credit. The credit will be awarded to the student after the submission of summer internship/ industrial training report to the Head of the Department. The report will be evaluated by a team of faculty members nominated by the Head of the Department for awarding the grade. Based on the recommendation by the team, the student will be awarded credits and the results will be sent to The Controller of Examinations after the approval by the Head of the Department. Each student has to earn 2 credits through internship in order to be eligible for the award of the Degree. However it will not be considered for CGPA calculations.</p>	<p>Each student has to undergo internship in an industry or at the institution. Two weeks of internship at industry/institution is equivalent to 1 credit. The internship report will be evaluated by a team of faculty members nominated by the Head of the Department for awarding the grade. Based on the recommendation by the team, the student will be awarded grade and credit and the results will be sent to The Controller of Examinations to indicate in the Mark Sheet. Each student has to earn 3 credits (6 Weeks) through internship in order to be eligible for the award of the Degree. However it will not be considered for CGPA calculations.</p> <p>In addition to the minimum requirement, of 3 credits, if a student earns 3 more credits (6 Weeks of internship in one organization), the student may drop one Programme Elective. However, if the number of credits earned is 1 or 2, these credits shall not be considered for exemption from Programme Elective</p>
